Information sheet of the Foreigners' Registration Office of the District of

Entry into the Federal Republic of Germany for a longer-term stay is usually granted with a visa in accordance with Section 5 (2) sentence 1 of the Residence Act (AufenthG), issued by the German diplomatic mission in your home country.

The required information on the purpose of your stay must be provided when you apply for a visa and must be truthful in accordance with Section 5 (2) sentence 1 no. 2 AufenthG.

If it transpires during the course of your stay and during your visit to the immigration authority that you have provided false information in the visa procedure in order to make it easier to obtain an actual intended stay after entry (visa fraud), this constitutes a violation of Section 5 (2) sentence 1 no. 2 AufenthG.

The immigration authority is then authorised to refuse to issue a residence permit. Subsequently, you may be asked to leave the country or be deported altogether.

Additional information for persons with a visa to prepare for studies or to study according to § 16 b AufenthG:

If you originally applied for and received your visa for a place other than the district of Goslar, you must go to that place immediately after your arrival. A residence permit is not issued in the district of Goslar. If you submit an application in the district of Goslar, your application will be rejected after a proper hearing with the request to go to your original destination or to leave the Federal Republic of Germany.
